

Jesus Teachings in the 4 Gospels

“Ask, and it will be given you. Seek, and you will find. Knock, and it will be opened for you. For everyone who asks receives. He who seeks finds. To him who knocks it will be opened. (Jesus teaching in Matthew 7:7-8 WEB)

“Come to me, all you who labor and are heavily burdened, and I will give you rest. (Jesus teaching in Matthew 11:28 WEB)

But seek first God’s Kingdom, and his righteousness; and all these things will be given to you as well. (Jesus teaching in Matthew 6:33 WEB)

“Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like treasure hidden in the field, which a man found, and hid. In his joy, he goes and sells all that he has, and buys that field. (Jesus teaching in Matthew 13:44 WEB)

Jesus said to him, “‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the first and great commandment. (Jesus teaching in Matthew 22:37-38 WEB)

A second likewise is this, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ (Jesus teaching in Matthew 22:39 WEB)

“His lord said to him, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a few things, I will set you over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.’ (Jesus teaching in Matthew 25:21 WEB)

For what does it profit a man, to gain the whole world, and forfeit his life? (Jesus teaching in Mark 8:36 WEB)

The lamp of the body is the eye. Therefore when your eye is good, your whole body is also full of light; but when it is evil, your body also is full of darkness. Therefore see whether the light that is in you isn’t darkness. (Jesus teaching in Luke 11:34-35 WEB)

As many as don’t receive you, when you depart from that city, shake off even the dust from your feet for a testimony against them.” (Jesus teaching in Luke 9:5 WEB)

He said to all, “If anyone desires to come after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. (Jesus teaching in Luke 9:23 WEB)

Whoever listens to you listens to me, and whoever rejects you rejects me. Whoever rejects me rejects him who sent me.” (Jesus teaching in Luke 10:16 WEB)

When he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!’ I tell you that even so there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents, than over ninety-nine righteous people who need no repentance. (Jesus teaching in Luke 15:6-7 WEB)

“Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done.” (Jesus teaching in Luke 22:42 WEB)

Jesus answered him, “Most certainly, I tell you, unless one is born anew, he can’t see God’s Kingdom.” (Jesus teaching in John 3:3 WEB)

For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God didn’t send his Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world should be saved through him. (Jesus teaching in John 3:16-17 WEB)

“Most certainly I tell you, he who hears my word, and believes him who sent me, has eternal life, and doesn’t come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life. (Jesus teaching in John 5:24 WEB)

All those whom the Father gives me will come to me. He who comes to me I will in no way throw out. For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will, but the will of him who sent me. This is the will of my Father who sent me, that of all he has given to me I should lose nothing, but should raise him up at the last day. This is the will of the one who sent me, that everyone who sees the Son, and believes in him, should have eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.” (Jesus teaching in John 6:37-40 WEB)

On the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." (Jesus teaching in John 7:37-38 NKJV)

Jesus therefore said to those Jews who had believed him, “If you remain in my word, then you are truly my disciples. You will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.” (Jesus teaching in John 8:31-32 WEB)

Therefore the Father loves me, because I lay down my life, that I may take it again. No one takes it away from me, but I lay it down by myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. I received this commandment from my Father.” (Jesus teaching in John 10:17-18 WEB)

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. I give eternal life to them. They will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all. No one is able to snatch them out of my Father’s hand. (Jesus teaching in John 10:27-29 WEB)

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me. (Jesus teaching in John 14:6 WEB)

I am the vine. You are the branches. He who remains in me, and I in him, the same bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. (Jesus teaching in John 15:5 WEB)

“This is my commandment, that you love one another, even as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. (Jesus teaching in John 15:12-13 WEB)

I pray for them. I don’t pray for the world, but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours. (Jesus teaching in John 17:9 WEB)

Immediately he made his disciples get into the boat, and to go ahead to the other side, to Bethsaida, while he himself sent the multitude away. After he had taken leave of them, he went up the mountain to pray. When evening had come, the boat was in the middle of the sea, and he was alone on the land. Seeing them distressed in rowing, for the wind was contrary to them, about the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea, and he would have passed by them, but they, when they saw him walking on the sea, supposed that it was a ghost, and cried out; for they all saw him, and were troubled. But he immediately spoke with them, and said to them,

“Have courage! It is I! Don’t be afraid.”

He got into the boat with them; and the wind ceased, and they were very amazed among themselves, and marveled. (Jesus teaching in Mark 6:45-51)
